<u>Civic Freedom Monitor</u>: ICNL's Civic Freedom Monitor provides up-to-date information on legal issues affecting civil society and civic freedoms, including freedoms of association, expression, and peaceful assembly. We currently maintain reports on 50+ countries and eight multilateral organizations.

<u>Digital Legal Library</u>: The Digital Legal Library houses a collection of nearly 4,000 resources from more than 200 countries and territories, written in more than 60 languages. The database contains laws, reports, and other civil society legal resources. You can search the library using the text bar or browse by topic, country, language, or document type using the drop-down menus.

<u>COVID-19 Civic Freedom Tracker</u>: This tracker monitors government responses to the pandemic that affect civic freedoms and human rights, focusing on emergency laws.

<u>Civic Space 2040</u>: Civic Space 2040 is a futurist initiative to craft a positive vision for civic space and map strategies to make it a reality. The initiative explores trends that will radically transform the world and discusses how they will impact civic space.
