Policy Level Advocacy:


* Involves the development of independent publications (position papers, policy briefs, case studies, experiences etc)


Community Level Advocacy:

What is a Movement?

- 1. A program or series of acts working toward a desired end a reform **movement**.
- 2. A (social) movement is a loosely organized effort by a large group of people to achieve a particular goal, typically a social or political one. This may be to carry out, resist or undo a social change. It is a type of group action and may involve individuals, organizations or both



Movement Building

It means working on the collective processes and infrastructure that create <u>shared vision</u>, <u>strategy</u>, and action across different areas of social, economic, and ecological justice.

Movement Types

- 1. Legal/Formal (Registered)
- 2. Loose/Informal (Unregistered)
- 3. Adhoc
- 4. Long term

➢Impact


Disadvantages

Illustrated Anti-Coal Campaign Story




Youth in Renewable Energy Movement campaign
