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CHILDREN INVOLVEMENT IN OUTCOME MAPPING & HARVESTING



Participatory Sessions:

- We encourage children to share their stories and narratives about the changes they have observed or experienced as a result of the project.
- Through Friendship Groups (FGs) Planning sessions are held with children in which they air out their opinions /give input on prospect activities. This includes post activity feedback sessions.
- Use of interactive activities (community open days and games) to engage children in expressing their opinions and understanding about outcome challenge.

CHILDREN INVOLVEMENT IN OUTCOME MAPPING & HARVESTING



- We use outcome mapping technique visuals (e.g. we have simplified the circle of courage model we use to implement the project) that are engaging and easily understandable for children.
- Monitoring/tracking behavior Change is done through measuring the frequency of FG meetings, in which children are involved.
- Monitoring is also conducted through indicators (progress markers) which are related to the desired behavior change.
